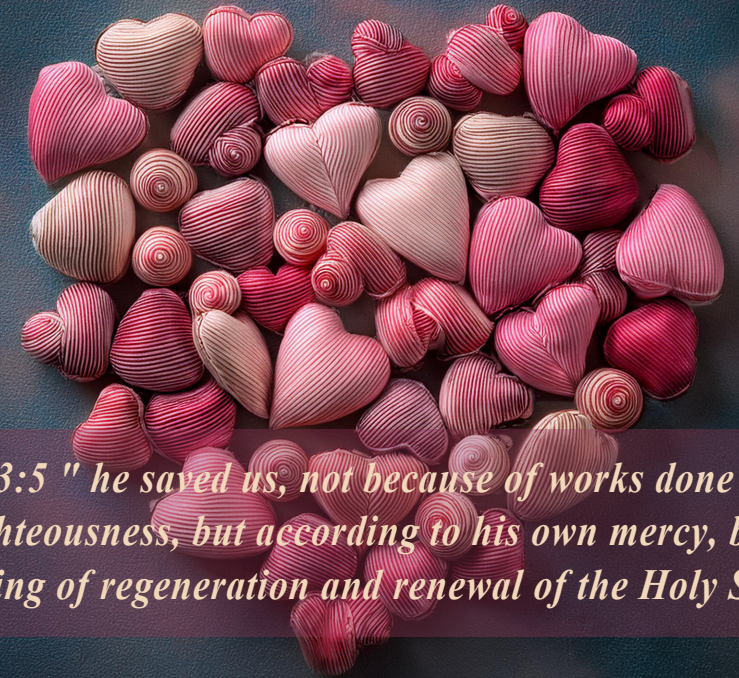

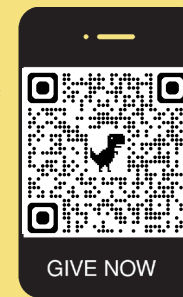
Giving

Call to Prayer

Persecuted Church: Saudi Arabia - Saudi Arabia is one of the world's most restricted and difficult environments for Christians, especially those who convert from Islam. One church has been allowed for foreign Christian workers, but no other churches are permitted. Conversions from Islam are considered apostasy by law and are punishable by death. But Saudis who convert are more likely to be killed by family members than to be imprisoned or otherwise punished by the government..

- Pray for increased access to God's Word through creative means.
- Pray that those who must worship in secret will have opportunities for fellowship with other Christians.
- Praise God for the bold faith of Saudis who leave Islam to follow Christ, an act punishable by death.
- Pray that Christian converts from Islam will know the right time to share their faith with family members.
- Pray that sharing the gospel through digital media will be effective in this highly restricted country.
