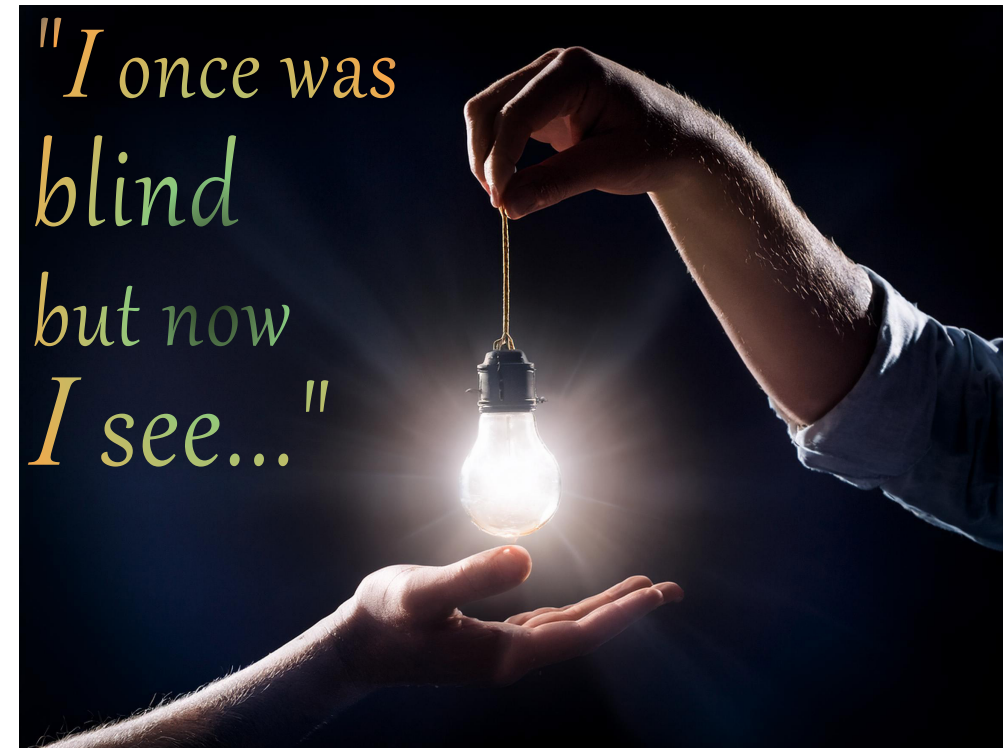

Persecuted Church: Nepal -

The government of Nepal is taking an increasingly strong stand against religious conversion. and Parliament criminalized converting someone to another religion. There is a small, visible Christian community in Nepal, but believers experience opposition from extremists among the Hindu, Muslim, Buddhist and Marxist groups. Christians face false accusations, harassment and beatings from family and communities. They also face opposition from local Hindu nationalists who envision Nepal becoming a "pure" Hindu nation. Christians are considered to be untouchables and are ostracized by society. They are seen as people who "destroy culture" and promote foreign religions..

- Pray for Christian widows in Nepal who face severe discrimination.
- Pray for those reaching out to Tibetans in Nepal.
- Pray that laws designed to restrict churches will not be approved.
- Pray for successful youth conferences.
- Pray for those ministering to the unreached in remote and difficult-to-reach areas of northern Nepal.
