Persecuted Church: Tunisia - Tunisia has a rich Christian history. It was the home of notable church fathers Tertullian and Cyprian as well as the Christian martyrs Perpetua and Felicity. The third Council of Carthage ratified the New Testament canon in Tunisia in A.D. 397. However, there are now few churches or Christians in Tunisia. Since the Arab Spring uprising, the country has grown increasingly democratic; being the first in North Africa to enact religious-freedom reforms. But even with a rich Christian history and increased religious freedom, the gospel is opposed by many Muslims and has been slow to take root in modern Tunisia. 99 percent of Tunisians are Sunni Muslims. Less than one-half of 1 percent are Christians. persecution.com

- Praise God for the establishment of new churches as a result of increased religious freedom.
- Pray that many Tunisians will come to know Christ as the government allows greater religious freedom.
- Pray that the increased availability of God's Word will lead to a turning to Christ throughout the country.
- Pray that Christian converts from Islam will share the love of Christ with coworkers who may oppose their faith.
- Pray that Tunisian Christians will share their faith wisely and boldly, despite its prohibition by authorities.
