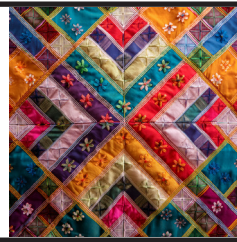

Persecuted Church: Bahrain - This small island nation is located in one of the world's chief oil-producing regions, but it has relatively small petroleum resources. Therefore, its economy has long relied on processing crude oil from neighboring countries. Bahrain has experienced significant religious, political and economic tension, resulting mainly from the Sunni-Shiite division among its Muslim populace and its involvement in the global economy. This unrest, coupled with the faithful witness of indigenous Arab and immigrant Christian workers, has led to a season of openness and some response to the gospel among those indigenous to Bahrain. Christian converts from Islam often lose their jobs and social status, and many are rejected by their families. However, some still gather to worship in secret.

- Praise God for a season of openness and some response to the gospel among those indigenous to Bahrain.
- Pray for Christians who are harassed and imprisoned by the government.
- Pray for unlimited access to print, digital, audio, children's Bibles and other Bibles.
- Praise God for the steadfast faith of Christians who lose their jobs and social status because of Christ!
- Pray that gospel seeds will be planted and take root in the hearts of Bahrainis.
